#### Position Description

**Membership.** The Water Recreation sub-committee shall have five (5) members total, and will have a minimum of one member from the quality of life board to chair the meetings. Requires an orientation, regular attendance at meetings, and participation in one additional approved training annually. Commitment is a minimum of 25 hours annually.
